Market Trends – June 2025 in Santa Clara County

Market Trend 1

It is not unusual to see a decline in the median price in the single family market from May to June, but four months of median price decrease in the common interest market is not typical for this time of year.

Market Trend 2

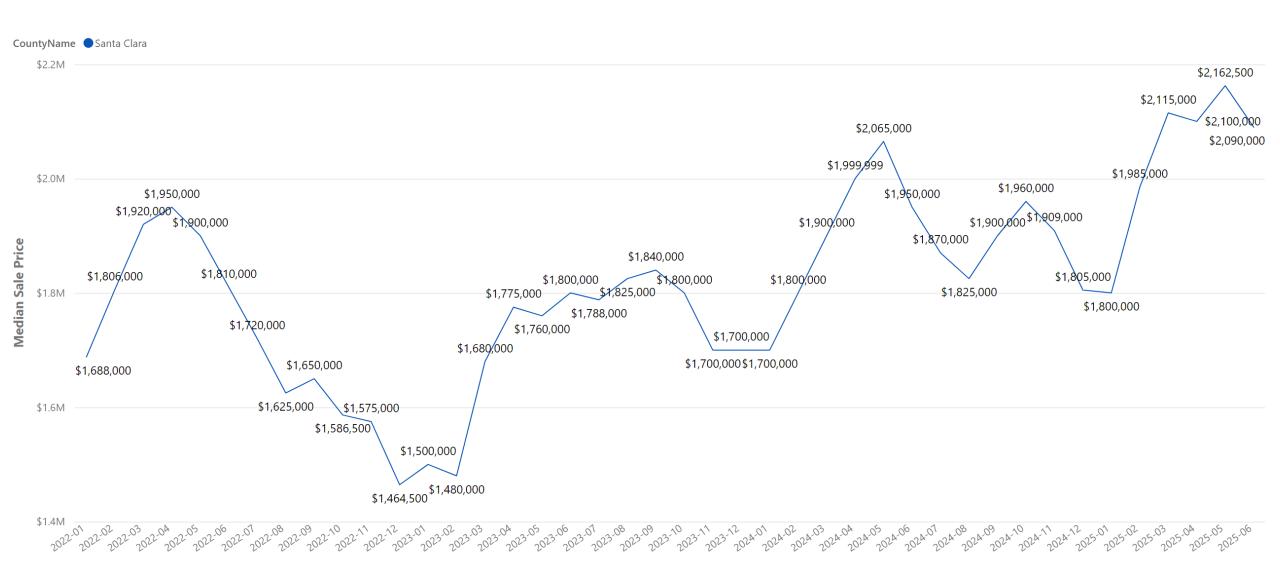
We have experienced a steady increase of new listings since the beginning of the year. The question is whether a slowdown in New Listings – with persistent, elevated inventory – will affect prices.

Market Trend 3

Sale to list price ratios are holding steady for both the single family & common interest markets, however, median Days on Market (DOM) has increased by 50% and 200% since April, respectively.

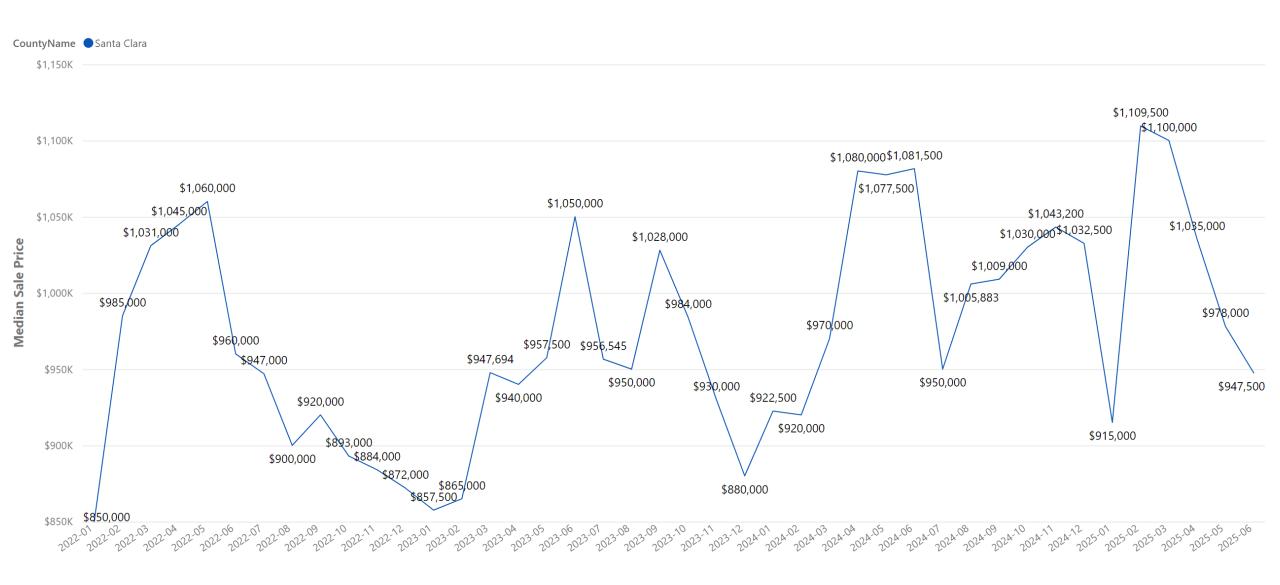

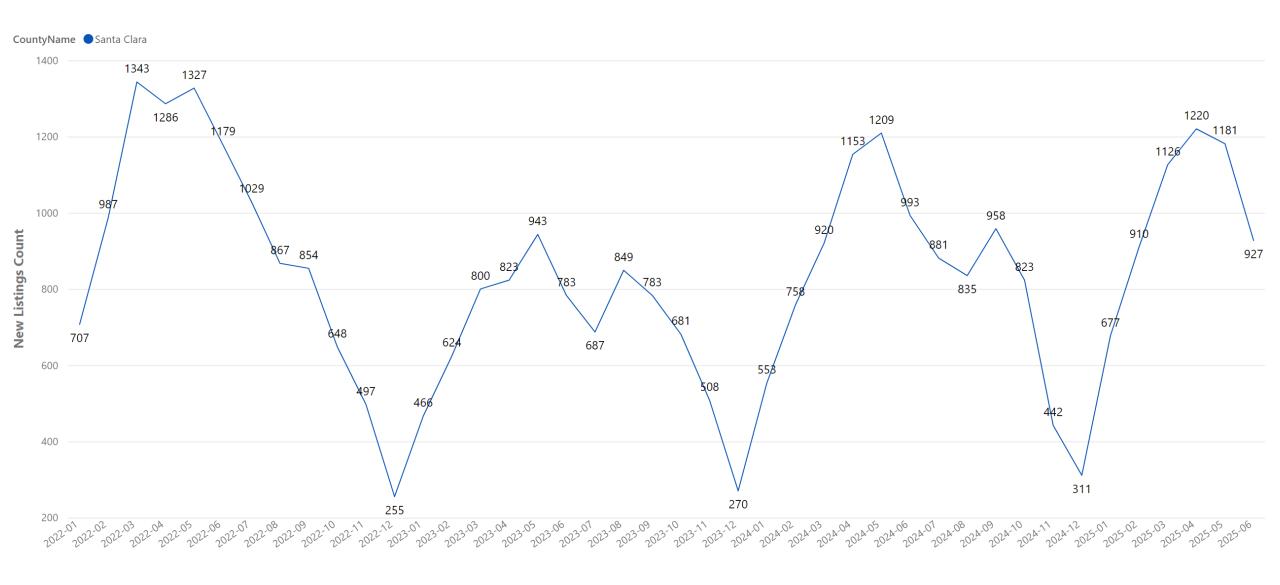

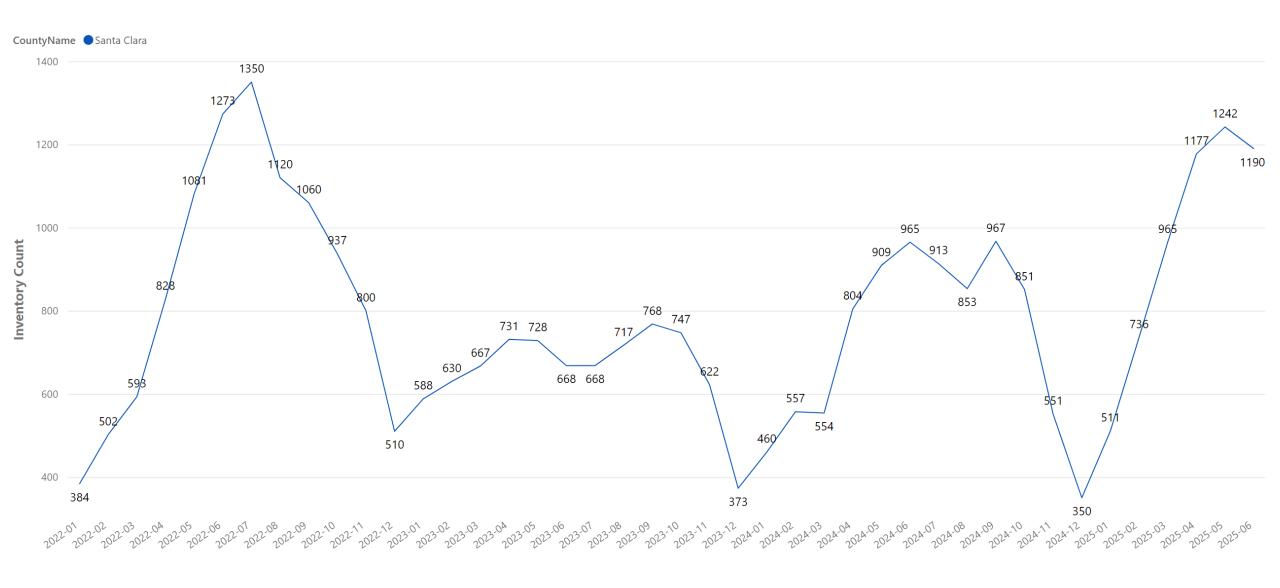

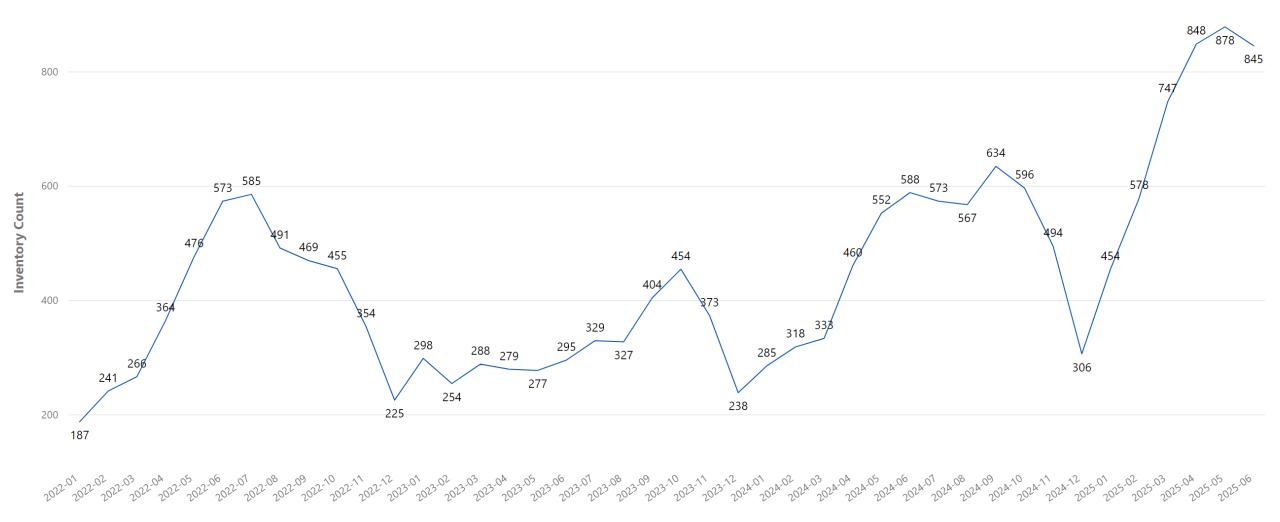

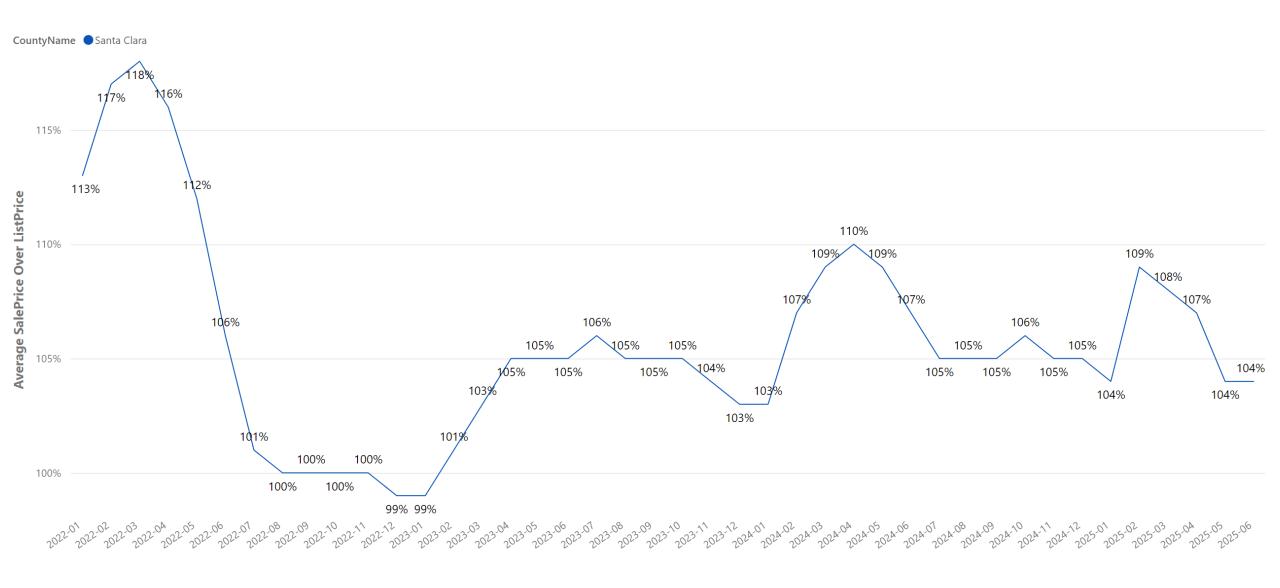

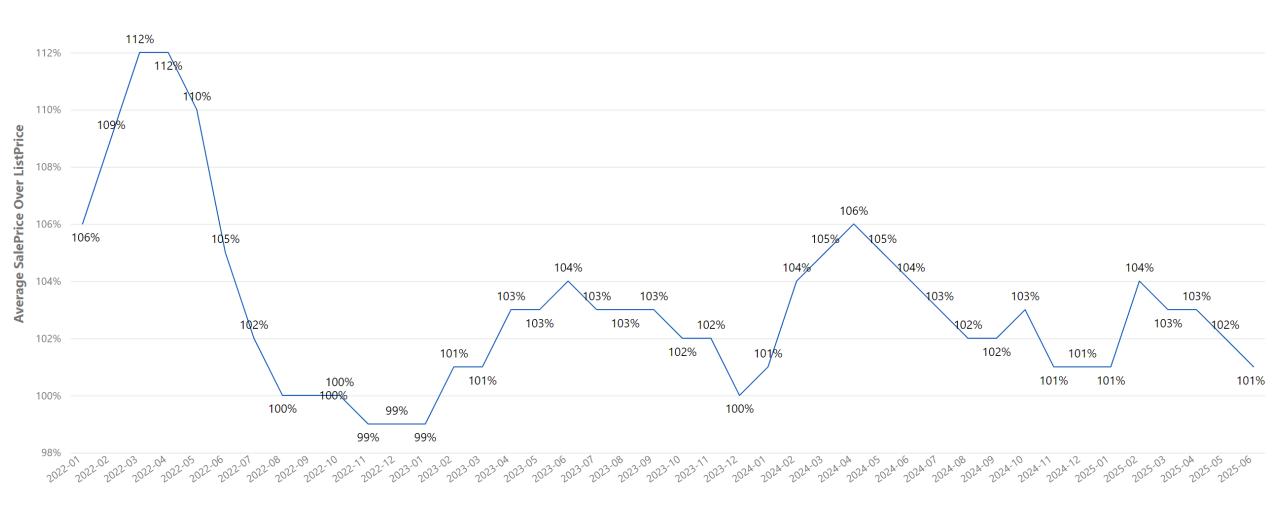
